Dog mess on the paths and on the recreation ground; dog mess on shoes and push chair wheels; even dog mess left in bags to decorate our beautiful hedges!!! Wanting to do something, Send Parish Council teamed up with GBC Dog Warden Peter Burnage (Tel 01483 444765) to tackle this very real anti-social problem.

But is it just antisocial? No, it most certainly is not as the worms dog poo may contain can - and have -.caused blindness in our

young people. Surely responsible dog owners know to pick up the poo? Clearly some do not.....and some do but still don't pick it up. But why does anybody take a bag with them on dog runs, collect the poo and then leave it in the hedge?! I think we all know why, do we not?

So a campaign just before Christmas tried to make sure that those that didn't know were educated and that those that were lazy were shamed into action. We used posters, street stencils and Facebook, increased bins where we could, and introduced enforcement patrols as part of the initiative. We were joined by the National Trust, who also suffer from dog poo laziness. The results of the campaign seem to show a positive improvement, so well done Send!

- New double yellow lines along Send Road – a help or a hindrance with parking?
- A disabled parking space to be provided at Send Parade.

- Vision Engineering's development progressing, following the signing off of all the Planning Conditions which were attached to their Planning Permission agreement.
- Possible work on the marina building in Tannery Lane, which has been approved but with conditions attached yet to be completed.

Finally, we wonder what the plans for the A3 will mean for our village. Will they include closing off the access to and from Potters Lane?
